### SOWETO DAY '89 WALKATHON

#### REGISTRATION PROCEDURE

1. Take clip off registration form from the walker's pledge sheet. Return the main pledge form to the walker so that they can collect the pledges after the walk. If walker turns in all pledges, then keep the entire pledge form.

2. Check that all information is complete, including total pledges.

3. Count any money turned in, and check off the "Turned in at Registration" figure on the registration form. Note the amount on an envelope, place money in the envelope and staple it to the pledge form.

4. Give walker an information sheet and a red arm band (in remembrance of the detainees).

IF the walker forgot to bring the registration form, use a blank registration form (with no number on it), have the walker fill it out and remind the walker to send in his entire pledge form with the collected pledges.

IF someone comes to register and has not received a pledge form, issue them a numbered one, have the walker fill our the registration form, tear off and take the registration form and give the walker the pledge portion so that they can get pledges after the walk. They can also just pledge for themselves.
