#### COLLECTION SUMMARY

Focused on jazz trumpeter and vocalist, Louis Armstrong, the Andrew H. Gibbons collection consists of sound recordings, papers, and books related to Louis Armstrong, collected by the donor, Dr. Andy Gibbons, whose research focus centered on the performer.

#### BIOGRAPHICAL NOTE

Andy Gibbons was born in Central, Arizona in 1926 to Andrew H. Gibbons Sr. and Lola Heaton Gibbons. The family moved to Logan, Utah where he grew up, leaving to join the Navy and serving on the USS Hancock during World War II. After his service ended, he returned to Logan to attend Utah State University where he earned bachelor's and master's degrees. He married Claron Gardner in 1951, who later divorced, and he joined the Air Force in the 1960s, and was stationed in North Carolina, earning a doctorate degree in Library Science from East Carolina University. At the end of his military service, he moved to Greeley Colorado, where he taught at the University of Northern Colorado, and married Janice Olmstead. His research focus was on Louis Armstrong and Thomas Crapper. He died in 2007 in Logan, Utah.

#### SCOPE & CONTENT/COLLECTION DESCRIPTION

The collection strength lies in the sound recordings of Louis Armstrong, the jazz trumpeter and vocalist, who numbered among the most influential figures in jazz. The collection also holds documents, serials, and books related to jazz, focused on Louis Armstrong.
